Phase 4: Finalization


- 1. **Client Approval**: Finalizing the logo after receiving client's approval on the design.

- 3. **Style Guide**: If applicable, creating a brief style guide outlining the logo usage, color codes, and fonts.

Phase 5: Post-Delivery Support

- 1. **Handover**: Final meeting to hand over all deliverables and clarify any queries about file formats or future updates.
- 2. **Follow-up**: Offering post-delivery support for any minor revisions or queries that may arise.
